## Drop Book Series Based on the writings of Luisa Piccarreta

The Drop Book Series is a compilation of three books written over the years as a homeschooling project. Initially, the sole purpose for creating a book was to introduce two young children to the gift of the Divine Will. The first book was written, illustrated, twoel together, copied on a printer, and hand-bound in 2004 by a family in the State of New Hampshire USA. When one of these "handmade" books somehow fell into the hands of a Korean doctor living in the United States, it was passed on to a Korean priest in Seoul. This priest translated and professionally published the books in the Korean language. A few weeks later (with the help of a massive donation from the Korean doctor), the priest and his team compiled the three books into one English volume and published it professionally at a Catholic Center in Seoul. The Catholic Center shipped several thousand copies to the United States replacing the "handmade" versions that had been distributed for years. This shipment of books from Korea was distributed within two years to hundreds of people throughout the United States and the world at a discounted price made possible by the generousity of the Korean doctor and with the help of several volunteers. The Drop Book Series has now been translated into other lanuauses. Check deviropoloois com for undeded information or availability.

## Note from the Drops

The Drop Book Series is not the work of theologians. It was written to reflect the growing personal understanding and experiences (over a period of many years) of several drops living with the glift of the Divine Will. The Drop Book Series is no substitute for the actual volumes of Luisa Piccarreta. At best, the series has been described by readers as "Clift Notes for the Divine Will" or "adult books disquised in children's Clothing."

For the most part, the illustrations were done by a little red-headed homeschooler, one of the drops. (This may explain why so many of the drawings feature a girl with red hair). Over the years many other drops helped with the editing, technical work, copying, binding, distribution, translations, and getting the word out. The Drop Book Project has truly been a cooperative work, a foreshadowing of the communion of saints.
